

## Compliance of Our Products With the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

Based on the version of the *Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)* amended by the *Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act*, the *United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)* has taken further action against 5 persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals as of 6 January 2021, and has introduced strict regulation of these chemicals.<sup>1</sup>

This involves bans and restrictions on the import, manufacture, processing as well as distribution of the following chemicals:

We hereby declare that we do not intentionally process any of the above-mentioned substances in the manufacture of our products. Furthermore, we are not aware of any product components containing the above-mentioned substances at the present time. We fulfill our due diligence by conducting a risk assessment of potentially affected articles and suppliers as well as a supplier survey.
